Young Scientist SFEC Award 2019

On the occasion of the 2009 World Conference on Carbon, the **Francophone Carbon Society (SFEC)** created an award to recognise a **significant contribution to carbon science or carbon technology** brought by a "young", non-tenured, scientist or engineer, **regardless of his/her country of origin and citizenship**. This prize is now awarded every year at the ongoing World Conference on Carbon.

The SFEC Award 2019 is open to **any French-speaking researcher** wherever he or she works, and to **any researcher working in a laboratory located in a French-speaking country/region**. The laboratory may be academic and public, or from a company and private.

The SFEC Award 2019 includes a one-time money prize of 1000 EUR (one thousand Euros).

The **enforced conditions** for eligibility are:

- (1) the remarkable results to be awarded should be **recent**, i.e. disclosed or already published not earlier than in 2018;
- (2) the recipient of the Award **will have to attend in person BOTH** :
 - the *World Conference on Carbon* (CARBON-2019, July 14-19, 2019, Lexington, Kentucky, USA) and give the related lecture in person. The SFEC will cover the registration fees to the CARBON 2019 conference.
 - the *Colloque Francophone du Carbone* (SFEC-2019, Samatan, France, April 23-27, 2019) and give the related lecture in person. The SFEC will waive all registration fees and will cover on-site lodging and food expenses.
- (3) the awardee **should not have a permanent position** in industry or academia yet by the time of the nomination submission.

Each awardee proposal is made by a "Nominator", typically a close colleague, or the candidate's supervisor if applicable. The nomination may come from anyone in the world. The members of the SFEC Award Committee will select the winner on the basis of THREE documents (PDF format):

- (1) An **Abstract of at least 4 pages** detailing the performed research, so that the Committee can fairly assess the quality and originality of the work. It can also be the reprint of the related article if already published, or the Extended Abstract of the CARBON-2019 conference if its format is adequate.
- (2) A **commentary provided by the "Nominator"**. The fact that the nominee is the main author of the proposed work should be clearly assessed, as well as the reason(s) why the nominee is fully eligible (quality of the work, originality, extent of the recipient's contribution).
- (3) The **"Application-Checklist" document** to be filled and signed by the nominee (provided as page 2 of this document).

Please strictly comply with the above-mentioned rules. **No other document will be taken into consideration by the Award Committee**. As the award is dedicated to reward the scientific quality of a specific piece of work, and not a sum of career achievements, **NO curriculum vitae shall be provided**.

The **deadline** for the nomination submission is set to Friday **February 15th, 2019**. Nominations must be sent by the Nominators directly to the current Chair of SFEC, Prof. Nathalie JOB (Nathalie.Job@uliege.be).

The recipient will be selected by the SFEC Award committee and **all the applicants will be informed of the results by Monday, March 11th, 2019**. The award will be given along with the money prize to the recipient by the current Chair of SFEC at any appropriate time of the 2019 *World Conference on Carbon*, as allocated by the Organising Committee.
